In order to receive points or mileage - ALL RIDERS MUST BE DBDR MEMBERS

Description of LD 150 and 300 Mile Year End Award Programs

Horse mileage program must be renewed each calendar year at \$10 per horse for either the LD 150 or 300 Mile Distance Award. Horse can only be entered in ONE distance program. If LD 150 mile horse reaches 300 miles in one season, horse will be elevated to the higher program award automatically. Must be signed up within 30 days of your first ride of the season. All miles are recorded by Tammi Thomas and must be submitted within 30 days after ride is complete. When reporting your results by email, please include the following: Ride Name and Date, Distance Completed (must be 25 miles or more) and Placing (which includes if you got best condition for endurance or grand or reserve champion in competitive). **Email Tammi at Tammimedina@gmail.com with your results. DBDR High Point Horse and LD 150 and 300 Mile Year End Award Eligibility

Points will be calculated for high point horse in all distances in endurance and/or competitive rides 25 miles or greater. Awards will be given for first Youth Rider with the high point horse and first Senior Rider with the high point horse. Must have at least 50 miles to be eligible for the high point award.

IN ORDER TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE LD 150 MILE AWARD:

- A. The rider will need to work one day of a DBDR club sponsored ride. Working will consist of a full day on the ride date or the work day may consist of marking a trail loop and unmarking the same loop as designated by the ride manager.
- B. Must obtain 150 miles during the calendar year. Extra work day miles for this program are not eligible*. Miles for this program consist of any LD distance 25 to 35 miles that's consistent with the description of an LD ride according to AERC's definition. Intro ride miles do not count towards the LD 150 miles.
- C. Mileage program is for the horse and not necessarily the owner. However, for the miles to count each rider for the horse must be a DBDR member.
- D. Work credit for the 150 mile year end award must be done by the rider who has the most miles accumulated on the horse in the mileage program and not the individual who paid for the horse to be in the program.
- E. Award examples to choose from for the LD 150 Mile Year End include (could change from year-to-year) embroidered shirt, embroidered stall bag or embroidered rump rug.

IN ORDER TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE 300 MILE AWARD:

- A. The rider will need to work one day of a DBDR club sponsored ride. Working will consist of a full day on the ride date or the work day may consist of marking a trail loop and unmarking the same loop as designated by the ride manager.
- B. Must obtain 300 miles during the calendar year which may include the extra work day miles (*see note below). Any distance mileage counts toward this award except for Intro ride miles.
- C. Mileage program is for the horse and not necessarily the owner. However, for the miles to count each rider for the horse must be a DBDR member.
- D. Work credit for the 300 mile year end award must be done by the rider who has the most miles accumulated on the horse in the mileage program and not the individual who paid for the horse to be in the program.
- E. Award examples to choose from for the 300 Mile Year End include (could change from year-to-year) embroidered jacket, embroidered blanket, halter bridle or \$75 towards AERC yearly membership.

*Should a DBDR member work any additional days at a club sponsored ride you will earn 25 points additional towards the 300 mile award for each additional day you work. Managing a ride is an additional 50 points. Email the ride manager to sign up for a day to work. Cap for extra points for working is 75 points. This applies ONLY TO THE 300 MILE AWARD, LD 150 Mile program is not eligible for extra points.
